Prior to moving to Texas, she was the Clinical Director of Speech Pathology at Duke University Medical Center. Since her move to Texas, she has taught at the University of North Texas. She joined UT Southwestern's Department of Otolaryngology in May 2004 to focus on evaluation and treatment of voice disorders, swallowing disorders, and head and neck cancer, with a specialty in laryngectomy voice restoration using trachea-esophageal prostheses. She helped develop the Clinical Center for Voice Care in 2008.
