Trip Description: Come and enjoy a kayaking day trip on the beautiful San Marcos River with Baylor University's Outdoor Adventure Program. With consistent water levels, consistent water temperature, rapids and the Rio Vista whitewater play area, the spring-fed San Marcos River is by far one of the most perfect rivers for fun and learning in Texas. We will have some time for practice, playing at Rio Vista and complete 6-10 miles of the river. We will provide the kayak, spray skirt, paddle, PFD and a handout. You are also welcome to bring your personal boating gear, but please let us know because it will help with planning.
